The Read Along feature highlights each word on the screen as it is narrated in the video, reinforcing early reading skills including fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension.

Paired with each video is a non-fiction eBook to build content-area knowledge and introduce real-world facts. Students can build vocabulary as key words are defined. A read aloud option allows students to listen to the book and see each word highlighted as it is read.

- T1 connection or higher
- Macromedia® Flash Player 8 or higher installed on every computer that will access **BookFlix** (this is a free download)
- Speakers or headsets
